Dear Friends,

Mrinaljyoti has been offering services to the Differently abled Children for the last 19 years. It has been noticed that the number of children coming to our touch is increasing day by day. It may be a positive reflection of our tenacious effort to spread awareness on care & treatment, education and rehabilitation of children with disabilities for which their parents are approaching us without hesitation. It is also true that the society and present government is more concerned about empowering the Persons with disabilities. As a result a new Act viz. 

STUDENTS BENEFITED

SCHOOL

Mrinaljyoti had been running a special school since 1999 and demand of time and necessity led the organization to begin an inclusive school in 2016. Presently the NCERT syllabus is being followed in the school from class I to VIII. To run this school we have got the prior permission from the Office of the Director, Elementary Education, Govt of Assam. The school is now ready to welcome children with or without disabilities to study together in an inclusive setup.

Students with high support needs are also given necessary intervention for learning, planning and participating without being judged in the special school section .

EARLY INTERVENTION

One of the most important services of MRC is Early Intervention. The purpose of the service is to identify the children with disabilities at a tender age and to provide maximum support services to make them ready to be mainstreamed and to cope up with different aspects of the society & life. The unit offers various therapeutic services like physiotherapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, special education, counselling, home management programme etc.

VOCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

There has been a constant endeavour to establish a permanent and well-equipped vocational unit. At present there are 12 children availing various types of vocational training from the unit. The products prepared by the children with disabilities are really praiseworthy. Activities that they handle are food processing, embroidery, knitting, stitching and weaving.



OUTREACH SERVICES

Reaching to those children belonging to the weaker section that cannot avail the services of Mrinaljyoti from its Duliajan centre due to economically poor condition or the lack of transportation, Mrinaljyoti has extended its services to them through its outreach centres. As a result, Mrinaljyoti has established two outreach centres at Rajgarh & Digboi so that the people from the locality can avail various services from MRC. The Digboi centre is in Ram Nagar, Digboi, and the Rajgarh centre is in Dr. Bhupen Hazarika Sammanay Khetra, Rajgarh. Approximately 129 beneficiaries are availing the services from these two centres.

On 14th November, 2017 the Children Day observed by Digboi Sub Centre at India Club, Digboi in the presence of Sjt. Suren Phukan, MLA, Digboi and the Major J.B. Singh, Army camp, Didboi. During the year 2017-18 a team of officers from Indian Oil Cooperation Limited (IOCL) visited the Digboi Sub Centre which was lead by Ms. Sabina Choudhary, GM, CSR, IOCL, Digboi.





JYOTINIWAS (HOME FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES)

This home is running by MRC under the State Child Protection Society as a CCI (Child Care Institute). The CCI housed **25** children with disabilities last year. They get the benefits of education and other services from Mrinaljyoti for their development & mainstreaming. The other wings of MRC have been always helping and participating in the various programes conducted by Jyotiniwas. Mr. Gopal C. Sarma, Member, ASCPCR, Assam visited the CCI, MRC with his team on 12th July, 2017. A few programmes under the Jyotiniwas are as below:

National Hand Wash Day (July 11th 2017): The National Hand Wash Day was observed with the children and staff of MRC to highlight the importance of washing hands. Videos were played for the students showing the importance of health and hygiene and the effects of cleanliness.

Child Rights week: The Child Rights Week was conducted at Jyotiniwas on 4th & 5th November 2017 where speech, art and hundred meter race was held.

DISHA

The National Trust sanctioned MRC an early intervention project under the DISHA scheme of the trust in the year 2017-18. The objective of the project is to mainstreaming the children with intellectual & developmental disabilities by providing therapeutical interventions like physiotherapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, and counselling, special education etc. within age group of 0-10 years. The project has capacity for 20 children. The project has strengthened the Early Intervention department of the organization. Mrs. Saira Rehman from State Nodal Agency Centre under National trust, Prerona Pratibandhi Sishu bikash Kendra, Jorhat inspected the DISHA centre with her team on 18.09.2017.

RAISE-NORTH EAST

Regional Action on Inclusive Education in North East (RAISE-NE) is a project to complement and support the inclusive component in Sarva Siksha Abhiyan (SSA) to increase the enrollment and retention of children with disability in the Govt. Schools. It is a 5 years pilot project (upto 2020) supported by the three INGOs viz. JVS(Lialiane Fonds, Netherland), CBM(Australia) & Light for the World(Austria). There are 15 NGOs working in this project from the States of Assam, Meghalaya, Manipur, Nagaland and Tripura. Mrinaljyoti Rehabilitation Centre is one of the 15 partner organizations.






