



Mrinaljyoti has been working for Persons with Disabilities specially for persons with National Trust category i.e. Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities since inception way back in 1999. The mental and physical ability of these children are very low in comparison to the children with disability other than National Trust category. Children with National Trust category disabilities need lifelong care and support services therefore they are mostly dependent on others either it may be their family members or guardian. We often notice that unlike their potentiality these children with disabilities are unable to show their ability what they capable of. This is largely due to not fulfilling child rights fully v.i.z. right to education, right to live, right to participation and right to protection. Even they are getting any benefit like job/educational reservation.

They are also human being and have the right to live with dignity and part of our society too. Though we continuously talk about empowerment of children or persons with disabilities still lots of work have to be done. First we have to help them to realize their capability and potentiality and only then let them to raise their voice for their right.

Mrinaljyoti, along with empowering the children or persons with disabilities also endeavoring and advocating to bring a change in the attitude of the people /Society. Our tireless effort is to bridge the gap among Person with disabilities, Govt. schemes, right implementers, parents, stakeholders of the society etc. Our aim is to make more people more dedicated to the service of the persons with disabilities. It is remarkable that the type of disabilities have been increased from erstwhile 7 to now 21 (as per the RPWD Act, 2016). Therefore our responsibility has also increased and we have lots of work to do in upcoming days. 

INDEPENDENT PROJECTS

1.1. School (Inclusive and Special Schooling)

At the time of establishment of Mrinaljyoti in 1999 it was a common scene that the children with disabilities were not getting admission in mainstream schools. Significantly, one of the most important rights of the children with disabilities was not fulfilled. So Mrinaljyoti started a special school for children with disabilities. A part of it was converted into an Inclusive school in 2016. Later in the year 2017, the school got prior permission as an elementary school under the Directorate of Elementary Education, Government of Assam. By converting the school to an inclusive one, Mrinaljyoti has been trying to provide the environment and materials both to children with Disabilities and mainstream children so that they can understand each other's requirements and thereby create an inclusive society. The main objective to keep one section of the school as a special one is to provide supportive services to children with severe disabilities who need intensive intervention and supportive care.

1.2. Early Intervention

The best time to treat something is at its beginning. As an organization, working to empower the persons with disabilities, our prime duty is to detect children with disabilities at an early age, so that the child can be provided necessary interventions. Our early intervention services include early detection, physiotherapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, counseling, school readiness program etc. The prime objective of early intervention of a child is to make the child ready to be mainstreamed. In this academic year seven children with disabilities have been mainstreamed and they are now attending mainstream schools. We have been closely monitoring their development for their good performance and still adding help by counseling their parents with options and tips. In the coming academic year we aim to mainstream more children with disabilities.

1.4: Outreach Centers

Mrinaljyoti has opened two outreach centers. The aim of opening the centres are to provide rehabilitative and supportive services to the Children with disabilities and Adult with disabilities in such areas where no services for Persons with Disabilities available. In such areas the PwDs are not getting supporting services which they need. As a result their development in all aspects of life is not taking place. Our effort is to help each and every PwDs of those areas to live a life with dignity. Details of the Centers are:

UNIFIED PROJECTS

2.1. JYOTINIWAS (Home for Children with Disabilities)

Since 2012, Mrinaljyoti has been running a Child Care Institute viz. Jyotiniwas Children Home under the State Child Protection Society, Government of Assam. The children home provides care, protection and education to the destitute children mostly referred by the Child Welfare Committees (CWCs). Children with Disabilities from incapacitate parents are also given hostel facilities here under the CWC.

2.2. RAISE-North East

Mrinaljyoti is a partner organization in the Regional Action for Inclusive Education- North East (RAISE-NE) project along with 15 NGOs and 3 INGOs and is working to promote inclusive education, barrier free and inclusive environment for the persons with disabilities in the society. It has already established an inclusive section within its premises and constructed a barrier free and inclusive environment for persons with disabilities within its campus. Mrinaljyoti has also been working with 5 SSA partner schools for implementing inclusive education viz. Kachari Pathar ME School, Madhya Zaloni LP School, Pragjyotishpur LP School, Naharkatia Town LP School and Nabajyoti Adarsha LP School.

3. UTTARAN (DISHA Project)

"DISHA" is an early interventional project that Mrinaljyoti is currently running under the National Trust, MSJ&E, Government of India. The aim of the project is to mainstream children with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities through providing various supportive services (early intervention) for the age group 0 to 10 years.

2.4. Community Based Rehabilitation (CBR)

In the month of March, 2019 the Caritas India, CBR-Forum, Bangalore tied up with Mrinaljyoti to implement a Community Based Rehabilitation project in 22 villages of Tengakhat Block to empower persons with Disabilities locally for upcoming years.



2.5. ICT Lab

Mrinaljyoti has begun a small ICT lab with 4 computers to provide opportunities for the children with disabilities for e-learning. In 2017, e-Saadhya e-learning tool was installed in Mrinaljyoti. This project was supported by CDAC, Bangalore up to December 2018.

AWARENESS PROGRAMMES

Workshop on Child Marriage Prohibition

A Workshop on prohibition of child marriage and Presentation on Juvenile Justice Act 2006 and amendment Act 2010 was held for Parents/guardians of Children with disabilities. In front of the present participants the students of MSW, Kaziranga University, Kaziranga performed a short drama on child marriage. Through the workshop Mrinaljyoti tried to spread awareness on the negative impact of child marriage.

Street play on the rights of Children with Disabilities and Inclusion

Mrinaljyoti in association with District Child protection unit organized street play on child rights and education on 29.06.2018. The children of the organization performed a street play at 16 No. and Tipling Tinali. The Centre organized another street play on 26.11.2018 as a part of an awareness campaign on the occasion of International Day of Persons with Disabilities at Digboi and Tingrai, Tinsukia District.

Awareness Camp on Breast Cancer

Breast Cancer Hub, America, organized an awareness camp on breast cancer in collaboration with Mrinaljyoti on 19.07.2018. Dr. Lopamudra Das, founder of Breast Cancer Hub was present as the resource person of the camp. The aim of the awareness cam was to bring awareness about breast cancer, its causes, treatment, way of preventions etc.

Anganwadi Training Camps

Mrinaljyoti in association with the District Disability Committee, Dibrugarh conducted a series of Anganwadi Workers training camps in Dibrugarh District from 18.08.2018 to 08.09.2018 on early detection & intervention of children & adult with disabilities highlighting the role of the Anganwadi workers. There were a total of 17 batches and 1745 number of Anganwadi Workers participated in the training camp series. Zila Parishad, Didrugarh acted as the supporting partner of the program.

Workshop on Prosthetic Appliances

Mrinaljyoti in association with Aditya Hospital, Dibrugarh held a workshop on prosthetic appliances on 19.02.2019 where Dr. Shrikant, HOD, Physiotherapy Dept., Ms. Tinomi Deori, Pediatric therapist and Ms. Sonali Mahanta from Aditya Hospital were present as specialists and conducted assessment of 25 children with Disabilities.



"UMANG", The Talent Show

Mrinaljyoti hosted"UMANG", a talent show for children with disabilities on 20.03.2019. In the Program Mr. Dilip Kumar Bhuyan, GM, Public Affairs, OIL, Duliajan was present as the Chief Guest. Children from Snehalaya and Ditiyo Swarga from Tinisukia district also participated in the program along with the children of Mrinaljyoti. The programme was supported by the Ministry of Cultural Affairs, Government of India through Zonal Cultural Centre, Dimapur.

Ring the Bell Campaign:

The campaign was conducted in support of RAISE-NE and Jana Vikash Samiti (Liliana Fonds, Netherlands) in 5 SSA partner school of Mrinaljyoti along with Rajgarh Academic Centre. The campaign beginning on 13.03.2009 and culminating on 20.03.2019 included more that 2000 school children and teachers. The aim of the campaign was to create awareness on inclusive education and increase enrollment and retention of children with disabilities in the mainstream Government and private schools. The children tried to bring the cause into the notice of the government, mass and media by making different noises for one minute.

INTEGRAL ACTIVITIES

7.1. Field Visits

Through the field visits, counseling & important tips are provided related to therapies, living skills, education, livelihood, accessibility etc.

7.2. Health Services

Dental Camp: Mrinaljyoti hosted a Dental Check up camp conducted by Rotary Club of Duliajan on 06.09.2018.

7.3. Assessment camp for Aids & Appliances

Assessment of children or persons for right detection is one of the most important task to provide adequate supportive services and certification of persons with disabilities. It is also the right of the PwDs to get certificates. Therefore Mrinaljyoti always focuses on organizing disability assessment and certificate camps.

Disability Identification Camp: Mrinaljyoti in association with ALIMCO organized a disability Identification Camp at Digboi on 23.12.2018 for distribution of aids and appliances among beneficiaries. The camp identified more than 150 beneficiaries for providing aids and appliances.






